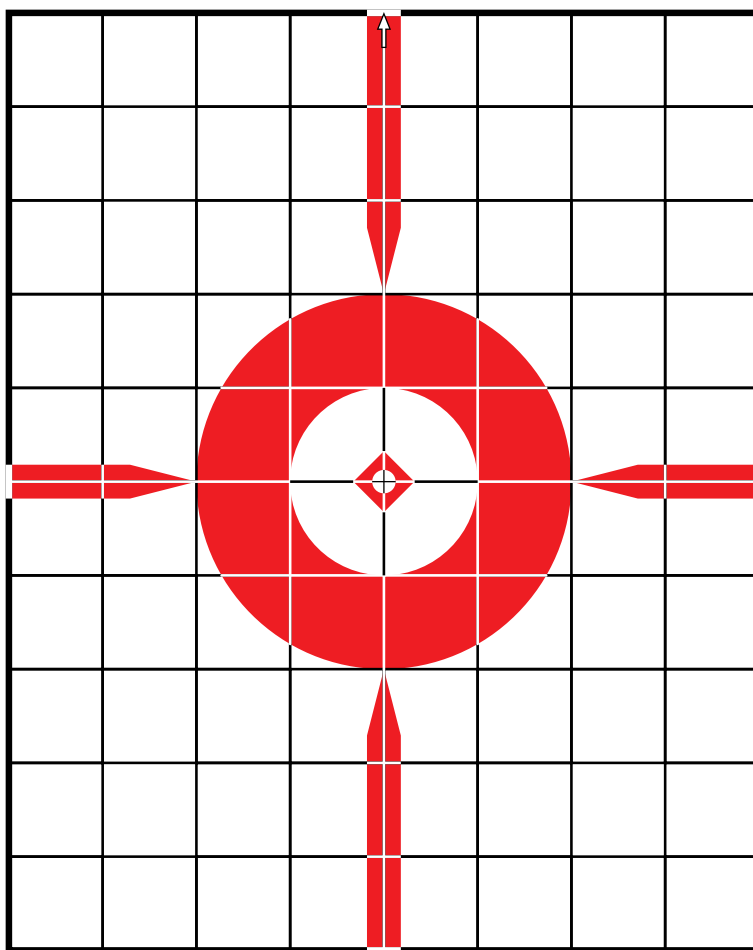

DBG/TTS has sold and produced many useful products for shooters and is most proud of the development of the Target Tracker© System. The design staff from DBG/TTS, working closely with law enforcement teams and suppliers, has developed a special version of the Target Tracker© System especially for law enforcement personnel. The TTS is now free for download to all law enforcement personnel and departments.

Law enforcement often comes in contact with stressful and dangerous situations, it is rare that the conclusion is not in the courtroom.

The deployment of tactical teams, including the sharpshooter and counter terrorist marksman is becoming more common. In the event of a shot by a sharpshooter his performance will be scrutinized to the last detail. In the courtroom the use of shooting records and range cards could become invaluable.

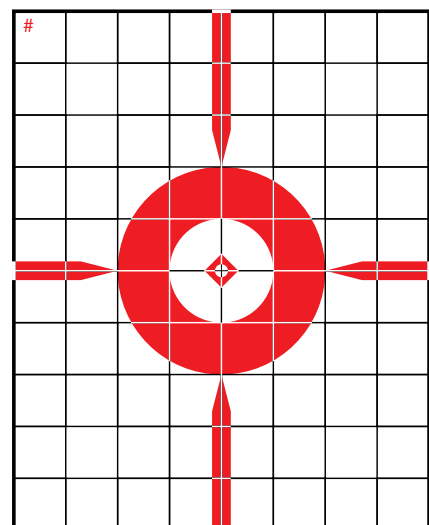
The Tactical Target Tracker© System fills a need in modern law enforcement and has many advantages over cards and targets of the military type. Often the sight of scratched out ranges and range targets of the realistic or silhouette type can cause adverse reactions with legal representation. The Target Tracker© System is concise and consistent and customized by the shooter creating, over time, a massive reference for the shooter.

The Tactical Target Tracker© System is flexible yet does not have the drawbacks of "homemade" records that might portray an unprofessional image.

The hand loading information for our standard Target Tracker© System has been replaced with two pre-printed tactical range cards. The standard hand loading information cards are available but most law enforcement personnel are limited to factory match ammunition and are better served by the tactical range cards in the standard urban and extended ranges.

The primary purpose of the observer range cards is to collect information for the possible, yet unfortunate reality of sharpshooter deployment. The range card allows the observer to make accurate, rapid, and repeatable estimates of range. Range cards can also be used for mapping an area for future reference in raids or deployment.

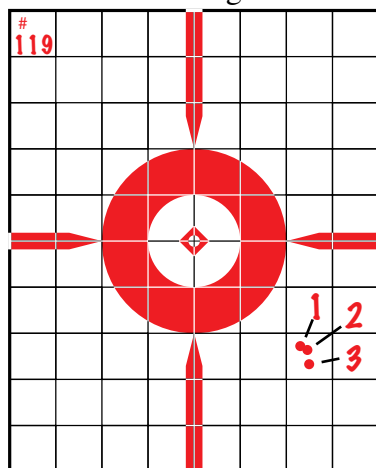

## Shooting Card

### The "Target Square"

As you will note the "Target Square" in the lower left of the shooting card matches the Target Tracker



Target ©. Each square is exactly proportionate to the one inch squares on the target. The square will allow the spotter or shooter to mark the exact spot corresponding to the entry hole on the target. The "Target Square" is the central

heavy square on the 11x17 targets and is the complete square for the 8.5x11 targets.

### The "Shot Squares"

Directly above the "Target Square" are 10 squares running the width of the card. These "Shot Squares" also are exactly proportionate to the central "Target Square" and allow the shooter to place marks approximately where each shot entered the target. The "Shot Squares" will keep an accurate record of the position of each shot fired. The "Shot Squares" have below them spaces for any changes in elevation or windage made for each shot.

### Cartridge Information

Below the "Shot Squares" and to the right of the "Target Square" are spaces for the information on the cartridge you fired into this target. There should be enough space to comfortably fit information on the bullet, powder, primer, case and the corresponding Tracker Reloading Log © number.

The four spaces are provided for the beginning and ending (correct) Elevation and Windage.

### Wind and Light Direction

The diagram squares for wind and light allow the shooter to keep a

record of the velocity (speed) and direction of the wind (ie, N, S, E or W.). Space for the brightness and direction of the light along with the condition (ie, partly cloudy, overcast or bright). The circle is marked as a clock and the arrow points from firearm to target. This will allow easy drawing of the wind or light direction in relation to the shooter.

### Distance, Date, Hour, Temperature Firearm, Scope and Position

These spaces record the distance to the target, date of the shooting and the time. Temperature affects the way a bullet impacts the target so a space is provided for the air temperature. The firearm used along with any optics (scope) attached to it are for identification and organization of the card files. The firing position
